Outside of school, I assist my coach and help teach war canoe paddling to younger ones. Two of my greatest accomplishments are graduating with straight A's in Halq'eméylem and graduating from the Abbotsford Jr. Police Academy. Last year, I was selected to represent the Abbotsford School District at the Inspire Conference. I plan to go to UBC and study Indigenous-based courses, and I am interested in a Social Work path.
